Notice of Race

1 Rules

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in the current version of *The Racing Rules of Sailing For 2021-2024*.

2 Sailing Instructions

- 2.1 The sailing instructions will be available after August 28th online at <https://www.atlantayachtclub.org/labor-day-regatta>.

3 Communication

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located at <https://www.atlantayachtclub.org/labor-day-regatta>.

4 Eligibility and Entry

- 4.1 The event is open to all boats of the Laser / ILCA, Sunfish and Opti classes.
4.2 All Laser / ILCA rigs are allowed. A minimum of three entries of the same rig constitutes a separate fleet.
4.3 Class legal sails are not required.
4.4 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form and submitting it, together with the required fee by end of day Thursday, August 31st.
4.5 Boats may enter the event by registering online <https://www.atlantayachtclub.org/labor-day-regatta>.
4.6 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

5 Fees

- 5.1 The entry fee is \$10 per boat. Online payment and credit card options are available.

6 Schedule

- 6.1 Monday, September 4

0930 Registration open in the clubhouse

1030 Registration closed

1200 **Competitors Meeting in front of RC dock.**

Lunch (on your own, not provided by the regatta but see options available as part of Labor Day weekend events)

1257 Warning signal for first race.

More races to follow. We will try for six races. No races will start after 1600.

Post-race refreshments, socializing, and awards at the Point Viewing Pavilion.

6 Scoring

6.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

6.2 If 5 or more races are completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. If less than 5 races are completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores (no throw-outs).

7 Risk Statement

7.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing Authority will not accept any liability for damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

8 Prizes

8.1 Prizes will be given as follows:

- 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place prizes for each fleet consisting of 7 or more boats, or
- 1st and 2nd place prizes for each fleet consisting of 4 – 6 boats, or
- 1st place prize for each fleet consisting of 3 boats

9 Further Information

9.1 All Sailors shall be required to wear a Coast Guard approved life jacket while on the water.

9.2 AYC prohibits pets, firearms, and motorcycles on club premises.

9.3 It is the responsibility of AYC members/guests to take appropriate measures to safeguard their personal property while on club premises.

9.4 Club Gate will be closed. A guest code will be provided to visiting competitors and will open the gate from 9am to 4pm. Please text Scott Barnas at 770.990.4179 to get code.
